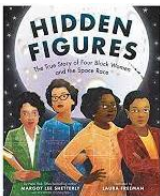
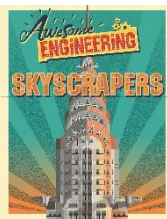


Year 6 Curriculum Web – Autumn 2 2025

Writing		We be reading 'Awesome Engineering & Skyscrapers' by Sally Spray and 'Hidden Figures' by Margot Lee Shetterly. Following on from this, we will explore a range of genres and texts including the poem 'Be the Change' by Liz Brownlee, Matt Goodfellow and Roger Stevens, which is a collection of poems offering the opportunity for us to 'save the world'.	Science	<u>Light and Reflection</u> In science, we will learn about how light travels, how light helps us see and how shadows are formed. We will develop a range of skills including using scientific evidence to support or refute on idea, using results to make further predictions and how best to evaluate test results.	Music	<u>Classroom Jazz</u> We will focus on the artist: Carole King. We will be able to explore the music and composition of her song through games, apps, warm ups and opportunities to improvise and perform. Our book to support our learning in Music is 'Meesha Makes Friends' by Tom Percival.	
							
Reading		Another book that we will read is 'The Girl of Ink & Stars' by Kiran Millwood Hargrave. In writing, we will consolidate our understanding of how to write for different purposes and audiences.	PE	Throughout the term, we will continue to have SOUL sessions with Darius weekly where we will learn a range of team building skills and find out about healthy body, healthy mind! We will also have PE sessions where we will learn all the key skills, techniques and movements in gymnastics.	Computing	<u>Web Page Creation</u> This half term, our lessons include webpage creation (designing and creating webpages), considering copyright as well as analysing website aesthetics, and how to navigate websites.	
Maths	In maths, we will be looking at composition and calculation for numbers up to 10,000,000. We will also be using equivalence to calculate, developing our use of key vocabulary including factors and product. Lastly, we will be drawing, composing and decomposing shapes.		Art	<u>Global Art</u> This term, we are learning about Global Art. We will learn about diverse artists from around the globe by exploring their history and background. We will then practise using their style and techniques to create our own pieces of art.	RE	<u>Buddhism</u> We will be learning about what Buddha takes inspiration from and how this helps him to explain his teachings and the different ways that Buddhists communicate their messages/sacred writings.	
PSHE	<u>Health and Well-Being</u> In PSHE lessons, we will be highlighting and discussing the importance of health (physical and mental) and well-being. Through our learning we will know the importance of different relaxation techniques and having long term goals.		Geography	<u>Green Planet</u> Our key question is: How does a climate dictate a biome? In class, we will develop our understanding of the importance of biomes and the ecosystems they are made up of.	Spanish	<u>Lead Questions</u> In Spanish, we will learn how to use unfamiliar language to understand a text by using visual and textual clues. We will also learn about how to use the word 'mucho' in a sentence and how to use phonetic knowledge to read new vocabulary.
