Curriculum

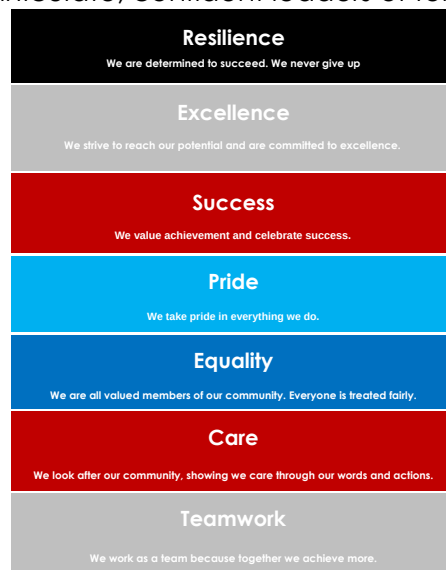
