Curriculum

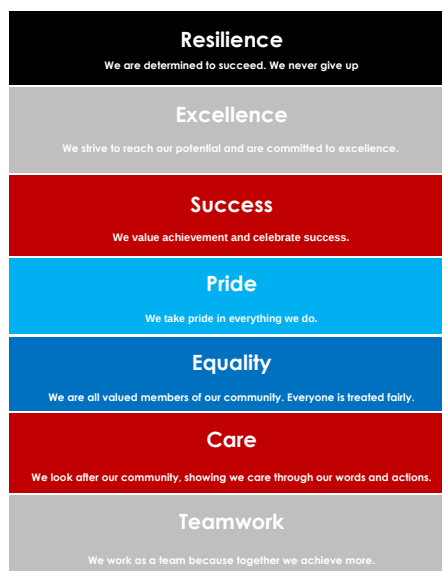

Homework Expectations

Reading

Your child will bring home two books, one will be a reading for pleasure book, for you to read to your child, discussing the pictures and asking questions about what they have heard. The second will be a decodable reading book. Your child will be familiar with this book and should be able to read it with fluency and automaticity as they will have practiced in class (these will be sent out from week 2).

Please read every night and sign your child's reading record. Please also regularly access the 'Reading with Parents' platform. Certificates for high levels of engagement will be given out weekly.

Phonics

Each week, we will send home the sounds your child has learnt in phonics. Please support your child in practicing saying these sounds and writing them. There will be a range of suggested activities on the phonics sheet to help you support your child at home.

Maths
